As we approach the High Holy Days, we have the opportunity to reflect on the past year. And quite a year it has been! # High Holy Day Ticketing Policy

To serve our congregation during the High Holy Days, we have adopted the following policies and costs. Please read the following information carefully.

## **KKBE Member Ticket Policy:**

- Your High Holy Day tickets are a privilege of membership. If you are not using your tickets, please return them to the KKBE office. **Tickets are non-transferrable!**
- Tickets for Members in Good Standing will be mailed to you in late August or early September.
  - Family Memberships will receive two (2) tickets per holiday.
  - Single Memberships will receive one (1) ticket per holiday.
- Your ticket is required for each service unless otherwise noted.
- No tickets are necessary for children 18 years or under.
- Tickets are also not required for military personnel with ID or college students with ID, **however, reservations are requested and can be made by emailing [shalom@kkbe.org](mailto:shalom@kkbe.org).**

## **For Additional Tickets:**

- **Family of Members** – Members in Good Standing may purchase tickets for family residing more than 75 miles from KKBE for \$125 per person per holiday or \$200 per person for both holidays.
- **Non-Members** are required to purchase their tickets in advance of the holidays. Tickets are \$250 per person per holiday or \$400 per person for both holidays. The cost of tickets will be credited to reduce a person's first year membership dues if he/she joins KKBE as a member within 30 days after the High Holy Days.

Tickets are available at no cost for individuals who furnish the office in advance a letter from their **out of state synagogue** certifying that the individual/family is currently a member in good standing of that synagogue.

## **Will Call:**

All purchased tickets will be held at will call and available for pick up at each High Holy Day service. Tickets can be purchased through the [KKBE website](#).

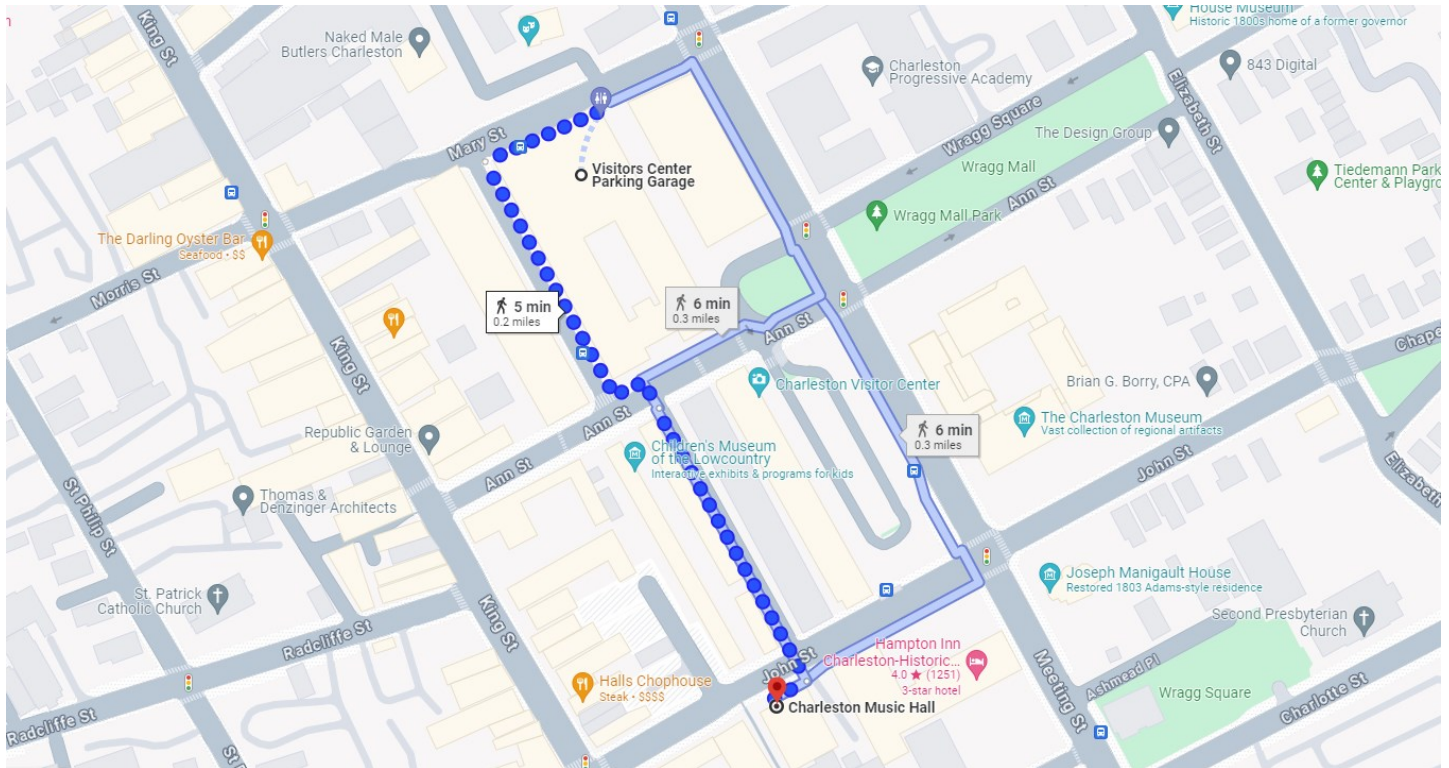

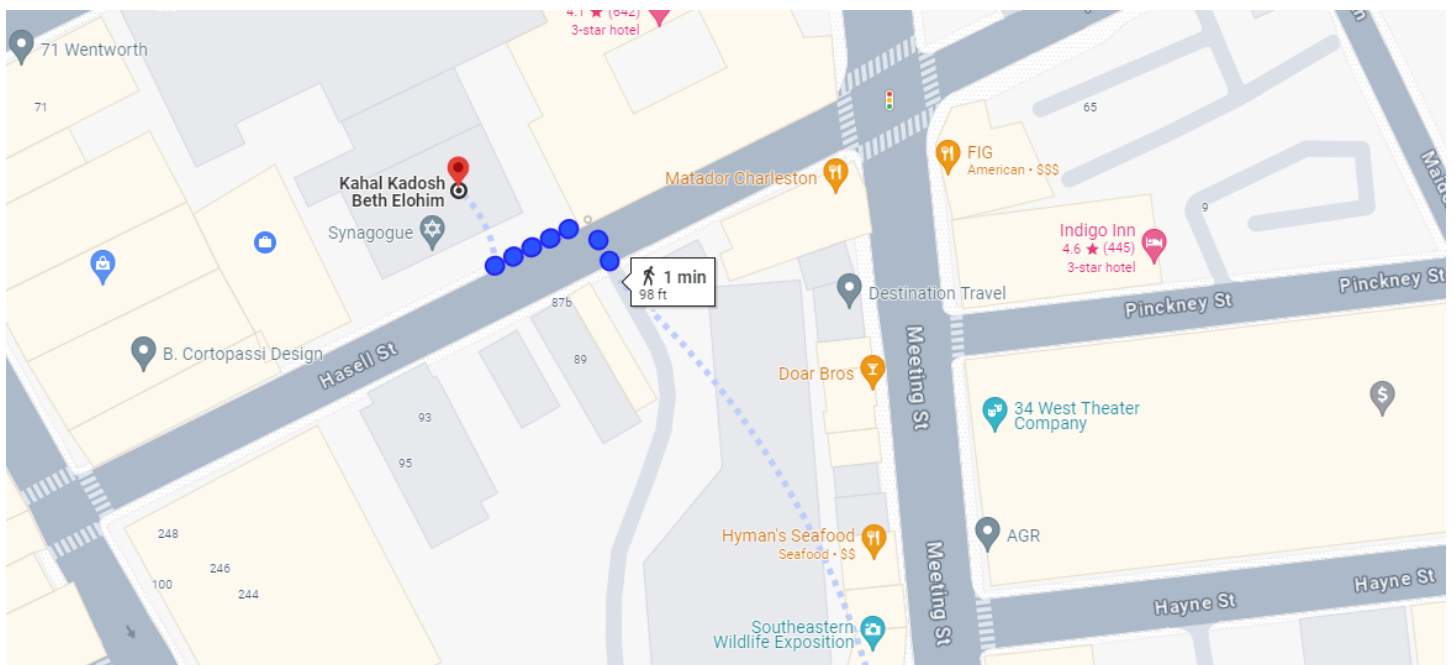
